### ART CONTEST CATEGORIES

- Middle School Students in Stephens and Jefferson County
- High School Students in Stephens and Jefferson County

### PRIZES

- High School: \$100 for first place, \$75 for second place, \$50 for third place
- Middle School: \$100 for first place, \$75 for second place, \$50 for third place
- Winners of the contest will have their art displayed in Dr. Che Miller's art gallery located at his office.
- Winners of the contest will also have their art work turned into a banner that will be hung at Fuqua Park

### ARTISTIC PARAMETERS

- Markers, Pencils, Colored Pencils, and Pens may be used. Digital media will also be accepted.
- Prepared Lettering within the artwork is accepted but should be minimal.
- The theme does not have to be written or printed on the artwork, but is suggested.
- Should not contain any copyrighted, syndicated, clipart images, scanned, or reproduced photos or artwork.
- Should not contain content that could be perceived as offensive, such as nudity or profanity.
